1. Why B.Ed in special education?

All schools affiliated with the CBSE should have a special educator in their schools. Special educators are trained people who support the education of children with special needs in regular schools. B.Ed in special education makes you a special educator to work in a regular school. All children should go to regular school as per the Right to Education Act, however not many special educators are available, hence plenty of opportunities in regular schools.

2. What are the prospects of B.Ed in special education?

Be a special educator for regular schools. Be a resource person for inclusive schools. Be a special educator in special schools. Be a resource person for open schools. Be a special educator for children with disabilities. Be a facilitator, consultant in several national or international organisations for disability sector.

3. What is the reliability of the course?

The course is recognised by the Rehabilitation Council of India and Affiliated to the University

of Rajasthan.

4. What is the Eligibility for the course?

Graduate (B.A. /B.Sc. / B.Com or an equivalent degree at graduate level). Minimum of 50% makes in the qualifying degree examinations.

5. What is the Duration of the course?

Two academic years

Two semesters in each year (Total 4 semester)

6. What is the syllabus of the course?

Course has Theory and Practical aspects:

Theory has: Core papers (Human growth and Development; Contemporary India and Education; Learning and Assessment; Pedagogy of teaching; Pedagogy of Teaching Language; Total: 5).



Cross disability and inclusion (Inclusive Education; Introduction to sensory Disabilities-VI,HI, Deaf-blind; Introduction to Neuro Developmental Disabilities-LD, ID, ASD; Introduction to Locomotor and Multiple Disabilities - CP, MD; Cross Disability and Inclusion; Disability Specialisation; Total: 6)
Disability specialisation: M.R (Assessment and

Identification of Needs; Curriculum Designing, Adaptations and Evaluation; Intervention and Teaching Strategies; Technology and Disability; Psycho-Social and Family Issues; Total: 5)

7. Is it a part time or full time? Does it have regular classes?

It is a regular full time course with compulsory attendance required by the Rehabilitation Council of India and University of Rajasthan. Minimum attendance has to be 80% for all course work, 90% of all practicum and 100% for school internship.

8. How is the Course Completed?

Exams are conducted by the University of Rajasthan. per semester. Minimum 50% marks



are essential in all course for passing in the programme.

9. Where will the classes be held for theory and practical?

Classes are held at Umang, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm daily. Umang has an accessible building, library, fully equipped physiotherapy and speech therapy department. Fully equipped sensory and assessment and room. A resource centre for the persons with disabilities and their families. Highly qualified and experienced core and visiting faculty. Stimulating and exciting learning environment.

10. How can one register in the course?

Application forms are available at Umang during office hours between 9.30-3.00 on all working days @ 200 INR.

11. When are application forms available? When does the course start?

Forms are available from 1st May. Written test will be held on first week of June and course/ classes start from 1 July.

12. What is the selection criterion for the course?

Limited seats for students on merit (based on written evaluation and personal interviews)

13. Is there a uniform for the course?

There is no uniform.

14. Is there an accommodation for the outstation candidates?

Not on the campus, however, assistance in finding accommodation nearby for outstation candidates.
